So in this section we are looking at the ways that the sponsoring club will support the applicant. This could be in the form of mentoring the applicant, or having them act as an assistant coach or second refereeing at matches

Measures and Timescales

How will the Activity and Support and Development provided by the club be measured and over what time frame will this take place.

For example – The newly qualified coach will act as an assistant coach at the clubs xyz training session for 10 weeks and will take part in a monthly planning and evaluation meeting with the clubs Head Coach. Or
